Meal Ministry Leader

Description

Throughout the year there are opportunities to serve members of Good Shepherd as well as those in the broader Rochester community by simply providing a meal during a tough time or a time of transition. The Meal Ministry Leader:

- o Helps to recruit people who enjoy cooking and delivering meals to people in a time of crisis, change or need. Recipients of meals are often identified by members of the Good Shepherd staff and members of the congregation.
- o When the church office calls and indicates the need for a meal to be delivered, the Meal Ministry Leader calls the next volunteer on the list to provide the service.

Timeframe

- o The Meal Minister serves a two year term, and may recommit at the end of the term.
- o Total time commitment is about 10 hours per year.
- o The activity of the meal ministry is based on need, so activity can vary.

Training/Qualifications

No special training is required, but the ability to organize and keep an ongoing list of volunteers is important.
