Description

The pig roast is held on Rally Day, which is the 1st Sunday after Labor Day. This is the start of Sunday school. Currently, the pig roast is from 5-8 PM in the evening, but this is subject to change.

Before The Event

- Order Food. We've used Bob's Smokestack in the past. Pulled Pork, Chicken, Buns, coleslaw, beans, paper plates, napkins, silverware
- Committee members bring or buy chips, dessert, lemonade and water
- Arrange for some type of entertainment (music). Darold Quam (Rocky) has been donating his time to this event. He is a DJ.
- Invite the youth group to be in charge of the games such as badminton, bocce ball, croquet, Frisbee golf, etc
- Put out a sign-up sheet (in the Welcome Center) three weeks before the event to secure volunteers to help set up, assist with serving, and help with clean up.

The Event

- Get to the church about an hour before
- Set up the tables for the meal seating
- Set up the serving tables
- Make the lemonade and pitchers of water
- Have people walking around pouring water and lemonade
- Help with serving the food

After the Event

- Clean up
- Do dishes if there are any to do
- Vacuum the fellowship hall if it is held inside
- Put Everything away

Timeframe

The Chair of this activity will probably invest about 5-6 hours total. Volunteers for the event will invest about 3-4 hours.
